Your assigned notary will provide you with a link to access the video-conference meeting at the scheduled time. Please ensure that your camera and speakers are functioning on your device (Smartphone, Ipad, Computer or Laptop), as we are required to do a live video in order to notarize your signature remotely.

In order for us to notarize your signature remotely: (1) you will need to be located in the State of New York at the time of signing, (2) you will need to present a valid government-issued ID during the video-conference, (3) you will need to sign the document during the video-conference, and (4) you will need to email the signed document to your assigned notary on the same day. The notary will then notarize the document and provide you with a copy and discuss any further instructions, including whether your document type requires an original. If you require a spousal signature on your document, please notify the assigned notary so we can accommodate both of your schedules, as your spouse will also need to be present for the video-conference. In an effort to prevent fraud and misuse the video-conferences will be recorded on the GoToMeeting platform.
